Inspection Report of School of Engineering & Technology, VPO Soldha, Bahadurgarh, Distt. Jhajjar to check the compliance report and consider the matter regarding grant of extension/continuation in provisional affiliation for/from the existing courses/intakes in the school of Engineering & Technology, for/from the session 2019-20.

The inspection committee comprising of Prof. S.P.Khatkar (Deptt. of Chemistry), Dr. Vikash Siwach (UIET), Dr. Karamveer (IMSAR), Dr Surender Singh (UIET) , Dr. Sukhvinder Deora (Deptt. of Computer Science) and Dr. Naveen Khatak (UIET) of M. D. University, Rohtak visited School of Engineering & Technology, VPO Soldha, Bahadurgarh, Distt. Jhajjar on 10/07/2019 with regard to check the compliance of the deficiencies pointed out by previous inspection committee and consider the matter regarding Continuation/Extension in provisional affiliation for the following existing courses/intakes in the institute for/from the session 2019-20. The existing courses are as follows:

- Continuation of B.Tech. in CSE with an intake of 60 seats.
- Continuation of B.Tech. in ME with an intake of 60 seats.
- Continuation of B.Tech. in ECE with an intake of 30 seats.
- Continuation of B.Tech. in EE with an intake of 60 seats.
- Continuation of B.Tech. in CE with an intake of 60 seats.
- Continuation of M.Tech. in CSE with an intake of 18 seats.
- Continuation of M.Tech. in ECE with an intake of 18 seats.
- Continuation of M.Tech. in EPS with an intake of 18 seats in 2nd Shift.
- Continuation of M.Tech. in M&A with an intake of 18 seats in 2nd Shift.
- Continuation of B.B.A. with an intake of 60 seats.
- Continuation of B.C.A. with an intake of 60 seats.
- Continuation of M.B.A. with an intake of 120 seats.

Observations

The inspection committee, as per the communication of the college branch checked the previous compliance report and compliance of deficiencies pointed out by the previous inspection committee of the University. The Committee also verified the mandatory disclosure made by the college and checked the status of College Portal data/submission of its hard copy to the university. The committee physically inspected the infrastructural facilities

viz. building, computer lab, staff, library, class rooms, furniture, etc. for the above mentioned proposals. The committee has made the following observations:

(1) **Compliance:** The compliance regarding the deficiencies point out by the previous inspection committee on 23.02.2019 has been submitted and order for the purchase of books has been placed.

(2) **AICTE approval:** The institute has obtained the approval of above courses from AICTE for the session 2019-20. (copy attached). The copy of mandatory disclosure to AICTE is also attached).

(3) **Faculty:** Institution has appointed one Director and 98 faculty members for all the programmes (13 faculty for CE, 15 faculty for CSE, 13 faculty for EE, 14 faculty for ECE, 20 faculty for ME and 09 others) as well as 14 faculty members for MBA and BBA programmes for teaching various sanctioned courses. (List attached). The college has appointed 41 non-teaching staff including TPO and supporting staff. Director and 22 faculty members have been approved from the university. Also proceedings of 24 faculty members are approved by the University. The institute in total has 1231 students in above mentioned courses. Further, the remaining faculty members at the level of Professor/Associate Prof. and Assistant Prof. are required to be appointed in accordance with the prescribed qualifications and the cadre ratio prescribed by MDU/AICTE and **all appointments be got approved from the university at the earliest.**

(4) **Library:** The Institute has a library having in all 38310 books for all the above mentioned courses with 3115 titles and subscribed 25 national and international journals. The institute has subscribed DELNET package having 1066 journals and 800 e books. The library has a reading room with enough seats for students. The institute is advised to purchase sufficient books for all the courses as per new syllabi and norms of the AICTE and M.D.University.

(5) **Laboratories:** The committee visited all the labs related to B.Tech./M. Tech., B.B.A. and B.C.A. Courses. The institute has 9 labs for CSE, 14 labs for ME, 8 labs for CE, 7 lab for ECE, 7 lab for EE branch and a workshop for the practical classes of B. Tech., M.Tech. All the existing labs have required equipments/apparatus as per prescribed syllabus. The Experiment lists and manuals in all the labs maintained well.

(6) **Computer Facilities:** The Institute has Computer labs housing total of around 421 computers. There is adequate power back-up. The institute has subscription of 50 Mbps unlimited, Airtel leased line and the campus is Wi-Fi enabled.

(7) The institute has sufficient classrooms (~35), tutorial rooms, drawing halls, common room for boys and girls separately and medical room facility. The institute has also various general amenities in the campus such as canteen, transportation facilities (15 Buses) and playground etc.


Recommendations



- Continuation of M.B.A. with an intake of 120 seats.




